Prairie Song is a Montessori-based, K-12 school serving Kirksville and surrounding areas. Ginger Nolker and Kate Sandefur are two of the school's founders.

While we are meeting at the church this year, the school is not sponsored by the church, and is not religious in nature. Our elementary class will meet in the Travers Room, and our secondary class will meet in Fellowship Hall. The school is a hybrid model of on-site and off-site classes, meaning that our students are on-site two days per week and learn at home on the other days of the week. If you pop into church on Tuesdays or Thursdays between 9:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m., you'll be greeted by a pleasant hum of activity!

Prairie Song is grateful to the church for hosting us, and the Academy is contributing some rent each month to help with utility costs. Our school operates on a sliding tuition scale for all families, making it equitable and accessible to all, and that wouldn't be possible this year without the generosity of our church!

Prairie Song is committed to diversity, equity, and inclusion, and an individualized education for each student. We'll have 35 students in our inaugural class, from ages 5 to 15, and are very excited to begin! Our first official day of on-site learning is August 24th.

We are very interested in nurturing multi-generational connections, so please let us know if you have an hour or two each week when you could stop by to learn along with our students. 

Shoes all sizes, Children's size clothing,


