- Deacons reported to Session several items: Deacons will begin to work with Josh to create a database for members and visitors. Cards to hand to visitors, or outreach to visitors after the service were also discussed. A class for new members was also discussed.
- Moderator Report: Pastor Josh attended the man hunt at 1000 Hills to help.
- We received a note of thanks from the Adair County Food Pantry.

- Employment contracts for the Christian Educator, Music Director and organist were approved.
- A curriculum was approved for the Christian Education programs. Youth group will join up with the Methodist Youth group this year. TBA for a Youth Lock-in.
- An inter-generational game night is scheduled for October 7.
- September 4 will be the kick-off for fall Sunday school.
- The motion to create four choir scholarships for this choir season for college singers at \$25 per event (rehearsal/worship), or approximately \$600/mo for 9–10 months, came from Worship and Sacraments, with endorsement from Budget & Finance. This will be revisited after a year.
- The "Route 66" curriculum will be used for Operation J.O.Y., talking about Bible skills.
- Children's and MS/HS curriculum come from the PC(USA) materials.
- House and Grounds are hard at work getting things fixed and checked up on. Among the
  many items on the list, air conditioning to be looked at, a toilet was fixed, a spreadsheet
  was discussed to help keep track of things.
- Outreach Report: Brenda has been working with the Clothes Closet. The laundry
  outreach is picking up steam, and Worship and Sacraments has been asked about doing
  a quarter-oriented special offering. Jeanne is looking into restarting community meals
  with Take Root. The committee has been asked to give updates to the congregation
  during worship services.
- Westminster Task Force News: Westminster House Task Force. Interested congregation members include Linda Hudnall, Mary Giovannini, Joselynn McKenna, Matt Matheney, Greg Marshall, and Scott Thatcher have expressed interest. Scott is willing to coordinate the Task Force. Michele Yoder will also serve,
